Device Specifications and Requirements



Operating System

The current version of Windows 10/11 or MacOS.

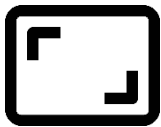
- Android, Chromebooks, Linux or iOS are **not** allowed.



Form Factor

A Laptop or a 2 in 1 convertible device.

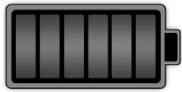
- All devices must have a physical keyboard.



Dimensions

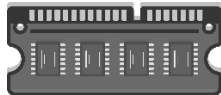
Minimum Screen Size: 11.6"

- Whilst a touch screen is optional, it is highly recommended.



Battery Life

A minimum of 6hrs battery life to last the school day.



RAM

Minimum: 4GB RAM.

Recommended: 8GB RAM or higher.

- Students completing TAS or VA elective subjects should consider 8GB or higher to utilise their specialised software.

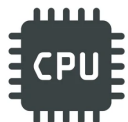


Storage

Minimum: 128GB Storage.

Recommended: 256GB SSD Storage or higher.

- An SSD for Storage is preferred over a Hard Drive (HDD) due to their performance and capabilities.



Processor

Minimum: Intel Celeron/Pentium, Ryzen 3, Intel i3 or M1 for Macs.

Recommended: Intel i5, Ryzen 5 or better.



Wireless

Devices must support the following:

- 5GHz 802.11n standard.
- WPA2 Enterprise security.

Note: Devices marketed as "802.11bgn" probably do not support the required standard.



Additional Considerations

Stylus	Whilst a Stylus is not compulsory, it is highly recommended to purchase one particularly for note taking in Mathematics and practical subjects.
Protective Case	Tough and sturdy to avoid breakage.
Weight	A lightweight device for ease of carrying is recommended.
Backup Storage	All students are provided with Cloud storage free of charge as an appropriate source of back-up storage for essential documents.
Insurance and Warranty	Be aware of the terms of insurance policies/warranties for the device. The school will not accept responsibility for loss or breakage.
