

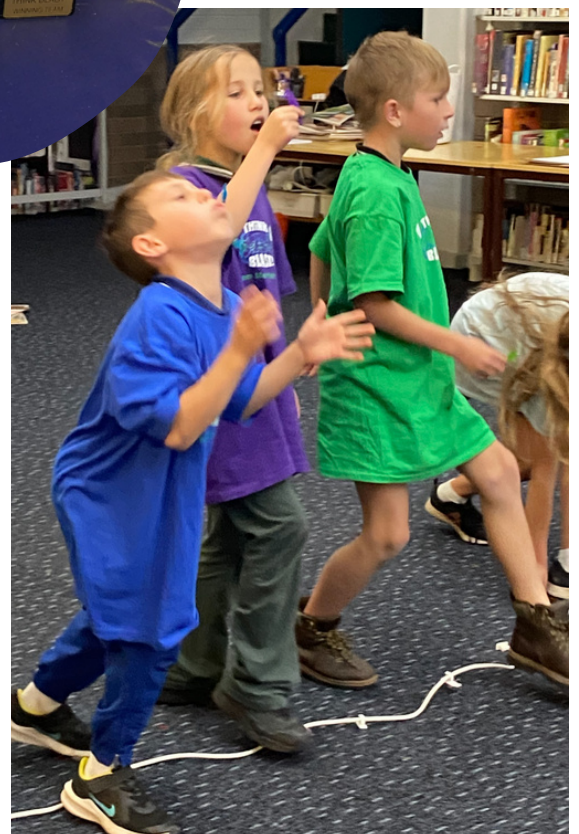
THINK BLAST!
