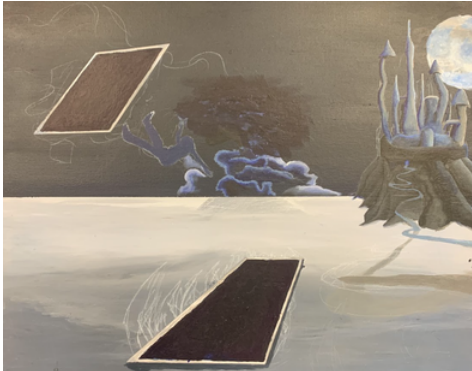
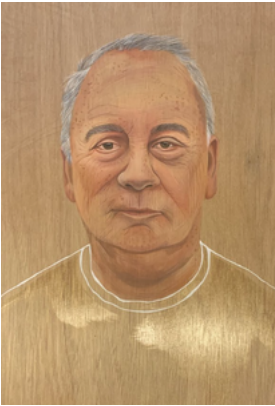


HSC DANCE
