Canteen / Uniform Report -J Moore N Murphy

- Our accounts for 2021 are in at the Accountant being audited at present.
- We will not be handing over any money this year.
 Due to 16 weeks Covid shut down 202. Takings are down
- Cool room motor needs replacing approx. \$4000.
 Getting quotes.
- Midford: orientation order due by end of March 2022 to guarantee supply for November 2022
- 1st July price increase on uniforms. Uniform shop has absorbed last couple of rises, but can't do that any longer. Haven't had a price rise since new uniforms came into effect.
- Volunteers: numbers down. Relying on teachers and P&C to assist. Canteen managers have tried to get more volunteers via Facebook posts and asking during uniform sales. Only 4 new volunteers in 2022 and 10 volunteers with no children at CHS anymore. After consulting with Principal and P&C president we are advertising canteen assistant part-time. Tara: CHS community use agreement for canteen unform shop. Needs signing and book in a meeting every 12 months. Jodie: applying to Bendigo Bank for cost of fridge compressor.

Open forum

 Chris: Asked about Agriculture Centre of excellence at Richmond? – Tara: CHS Ag students will be able to access. Programs will run and invitations will be open to students across NSW. Buildings at Richmond Ag Centre of excellence proposed to open beginning 2023.

Action:

Andrew: to look at user agreements and costs for upgrading cricket pitch etc.



Chris: assessment booklets were out of date. Came out late. These assessment booklets are important to parents to help. Can you create a calendar that parents can add to their calendar? Can you update assessment booklets. Andrew: this function is too difficult to facilitate to parents. Students can access this function. Year 11 and 12 on Central. Andrew could look at adding other years to Sentral. But there are complexity issues. Tara: could look at talking to students about using diary / time management etc.

 Andrew: parent would like to sponsor and upgrade cricket nets. Local cricket coaches looking to hire cricket nets. People can walk down from gravel pits so gates don't need to get keys. If used on weekend may need to provide keys and toilets. Contemplate user agreements.

Jodie: apply to Bendigo Bank re money for upgrading ovals and then these areas maybe available for lease eg CFSC
