BEHAVIOUR SUPPORT STEP 1

- Colo High School expectations reminder
- Restate expectations
- Request change in behaviour
- Invitation to self-correct
- Restorative chat

BEHAVIOUR SUPPORT STEP 2

- Relocate Student within the classroom
- Take a break
- Restorative conversation
- Call home
- Negative Sentral entry

BEHAVIOUR SUPPORT STEP 3

MAJOR

HEAD TEACHER/DEPUTY PRINCIPAL MANAGED

- Repeated minor behaviour
- Attendance issues/truancy
- Out of school grounds
- Fighting
- Forgery/theft
- Physical or verbal abuse of staff
- Deliberate damage to property
- Bullying
- Possession/use of illegal substance/weapon
- Cheating/plagiarism
- Continued defiance
- Threats
- Persistent or serious misbehaviour

INDIVIDUAL INTERVENTION LEVEL 1 HEAD TEACHER

- Continued faculty monitoring
- Restorative conference
- Lunch or after-school detention
- Parent correspondence
- Isolation from subject
- Re-entry to class process

INDIVIDUAL INTERVENTION **LEVEL 2 DEPUTY PRINCIPAL**

- Formal caution
- After-school detention
- Isolation from playground or class
- Monitoring book
- Exclusion from School representation
- Suspension

INDIVIDUAL INTERVENTION LEVEL 3 DEPUTY PRINCIPAL

• RFS agreement/reflection

- Task Difficulty/Differentiation
- Activity Sequencing & Choice
- Active Supervision
- Opportunities to Respond
- Establish Trust
- Build rapport to gain Classroom
- Cooperation
- Tactical Ignoring
- Utilise Quality Teaching Framework to structure lessons
- Use of non-verbal cues
- **Reward Positive Behaviour**

- Recess/Lunch detention 2x opportunities to attend
- Call home/organise a meeting
- Refer to Head Teacher
- Negative Sentral entry

- Faculty Monitoring Book
- Documented Sentral Entry

- Suspension
- Behaviour Support Plan
